# **BACnet Forum in Hong Kong**

## The 3<sup>rd</sup> neutral conference and exhibition for BACnet users in China

Hong Kong, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011. – The world's leading building automation manufacturers and suppliers will present interoperable BACnet technology at the BACnet Forum in Hong Kong. As the most outstanding event of the BACnet Interest Group China (BIG-CN), the third BACnet Forum in China is taking place on November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The "Buildings Save Energy" trade show will complete the Forum. BACnet experts will introduce sustainable solutions and the design of efficient building management systems with components that speak BACnet.

The BACnet Forum Hong Kong will join the regional forces of the current and prospective users of the open communication standard for building automation. It will provide usefull presentations on the benefits of interoperability and the exchange of experiences on the application of the open communication standard. It will introduce BACnet technology, systems and components from America, Asia and Europe to investors, specifiers, system integrators, consultants, facility managers and developers.

Hong Kong was chosen as this year's most relevant place for BACnet technology in China – as to a survey of the BIG-CN members and Asian BACnet vendors. Its prominent role in the development of the emerging Hong Kong-Shenzhen-Guangzhou region makes Hong Kong a centre for the planning of energy efficient buildings and for specifying modern building management systems that decrease the energy consumption of buildings. After Beijing and Shanghai Hong Kong will be the third location of the BACnet Forum in China.
