



BACnet Forum Shanghai: Key summit for intelligent green buildings

Shanghai 17 August 2010: The second neutral BACnet Forum of the BACnet Interest Group China is taking place in Shanghai during the World Expo on October 20th. “Efficient system integration for green buildings” will be the focal point of this conference. This event is already considered to be a key summit for the intelligent building industry.

Advanced technology and products from America, Asia and Europe will be introduced to one of the most important economic centres of the Chinese Market. All the actors of the building automation sector will learn about the immediate future of independent building system integration. Basics of the BACnet ISO standard 16484-5, the specification of multi-vendor building management systems and BACnet references from China and abroad are on the agenda.

“Green buildings” are the talk of the town. This concept is gaining importance for the highest authorities of economic development in China, which are strengthening China’s green building policy to promote the application of energy-saving technology for buildings. Moreover “green buildings”, “integration”, “intelligent buildings” as well as “energy conservation” belong to the guiding themes of the World Expo.

At the moment there are nearly 3000 intelligent building product vendors in China, and around 1100 companies are qualified in contracting with intelligent engineering. Most of the products sold by these vendors are imported. Thus it is evident that China will become the most important market for intelligent building system companies. That is the reason why the BACnet Forum Shanghai is bound to have a great impact on the building automation market in China.
